Na podstawie art. 23 ust. 2 pkt 2 ustawy z dnia 20 lipca 2018 roku Prawo o szkolnictwie wyższym i nauce (Dz.U. z 2023 r. poz. 742, z późn. zm.) w związku z ustawą z dnia 19 lipca 2019 r. o zapewnianiu dostępności osobom ze szczególnymi potrzebami (Dz. U. z 2022 r. poz. 2240) oraz § 26 ust. 2 pkt 2 Statutu Politechniki Białostockiej, zarządza się, co następuje:

§ 1

Ustala się „Standardy dostępności architektonicznej Politechniki Białostockiej”, w brzmieniu określonym w załączniku do zarządzenia.

§ 2

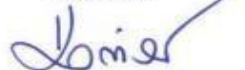

An Advisory Team for the Establishment of Architectural Accessibility Standards at Bialystok University of Technology has also been appointed at the University. The tasks of the Team include:

- 1) Monitoring the state of affairs ensuring architectural accessibility at the University;
- 2) Analysis and issuing opinions on the use of architectural solutions in the University's facilities that ensure architectural accessibility;
- 3) Substantive support for the University's units in activities in the field of architectural accessibility.

5. By virtue of the Ordinance of the Rector of Bialystok University of Technology on the introduction of organizational changes at Bialystok University of Technology and the amendment of the Organizational Regulations of Bialystok University of Technology, a new organizational unit was established - **the Investment and Renovation Center**, within which operates:

- 1) Investor's Supervision Department,
- 2) Power Department,
- 3) Renovation and Construction Department, 4) Sanitary Department.

The scope of activities of the Investment and Renovation Centre includes, m.in:

- 1) coordinating the work of subordinate departments;
- 2) preparation of documentation for tenders for construction, renovation and investment works;
- 3) preparation of the necessary documents for the implementation of investments included in long-term and annual plans, taking into account the costs of implementation and operation of the investment;
- 4) conducting settlements of investment expenditures incurred during and after the implementation of the investment;
- 5) development of renovation and investment plans, taking into account the durability and operating costs of facilities;
- 6) conducting financial settlements of investment and renovation funds;
- 7) control of the proper performance of contracts covering the scope of the unit's tasks, including compliance with the investment and renovation plan.
