## About FEM

Faculty of Engineering Management was established in 2001 by the Minister of National Education and Sports as a result of the transformation of the Institute of Management and Marketing which had existed since 1993.

Considering the number of students, the Faculty of Engineering Management is currently the second largest faculty at Bialystok University of Technology with over 1600 students. So far, more than 16,000 graduates have completed studies at the Faculty of Engineering Management. The faculty employs 116 research and teaching personnel.

Faculty of Engineering Management is located in the suburbs of Bialystok in the town of Kleosin. The main campus of Bialystok Technical University is three kilometres away. Trip from the city centre takes about 15 minutes. There are several public transport links to the Faculty of Engineering Management. There is also a bicycle path leading to the campus and a bicycle rental station nearby.

The Faculty of Engineering Management is a modern complex consisting of four well-equipped buildings. Didactic buildings have their own names: Montreal, Berlin, Philadelphia and Shanghai, which are derived from the locations of our important foreign partners. The are altogether 32 lecture halls, didactic and computer laboratories. All classrooms are equipped with multimedia systems. The premises are adapted for disabled students. In addition, the campus has a spacious car park. The large campus area of the Faculty of Engineering Management allows to expand it by constructing new buildings. Laboratory of logistics and a sports centre have been designed and are scheduled for construction in the coming years.

## Cooperation with partners from China

The Faculty of Engineering Management at Bialystok University of Technology intensively develops scientific and didactic cooperation with China. The main Chinese partner of FEM is Zhejiang University Ningbo Institute of Technology.

In 2016 both institutions established the International Chinese and Central-Eastern European Institute of Logistics and Service Sciences.



## University admission: As easy as 1-2-3

1. Send the documents listed below to our international admissions officer:  
High School Diploma with Transcript of Records (1st degree applicants) or Bachelor Degree with Transcript of Records (2nd degree applicants), English language certificate or a medium instruction letter, Application Form (downloaded from our website), passport photo
2. Arrange a Skype® interview with our international admissions officer.
3. After successful verification you receive your invitation letter. The whole process usually takes up to two weeks.
