

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Białystok University of Technology, ul. Wiejska 45A, 15-351 Białystok, tel .: 85 746 90 00, <https://www.bip.pb.edu.pl>, e-mail: rektorat@pb.edu.pl (hereinafter the University).
 2. The administrator, in accordance with art. 37 (1) (a) a GDPR, appointed the Data Protection Officer, with whom you can contact regarding the processing of personal data, by e-mail at the following address: iod@pb.edu.pl.
 3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of:
 - a) registration of the application and organization of the BUT Cup tournament under Welcome to Poland project "Akcja-Integracja",
 - b) publishing the results of the tournament and disseminating information about its winners,
 - c) documenting and promoting the tournament by processing the images of the participants
- on the basis of the consent granted - art. 6 section 1 lit. a GDPR.
4. Providing data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the tournament. The consequence of not providing the data will be the inability to participate in the tournament.
 5. The recipients of personal data may be users of the administrator's websites and social networking sites on which the administrator has accounts (in terms of disseminating information about the winners and publishing images of participants). In other cases, personal data will be made available only in situations provided for by law.
 6. Your data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the indicated purpose, and in the case of data processing on the basis of granted consent - until its withdrawal.
 7. You have the right to access your data, receive a copy of it, and subject to the provisions of the law, you have the right to:
 - a. withdrawal of the consent granted, with the proviso that the withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of your consent before its withdrawal;
 - b. rectification of data,
 - c. deletion of data,
 - d. restriction of data processing,
 - e. object to the processing of personal data.
 8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority, the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, when you feel that the processing of personal data violates generally applicable provisions in this regard.
 9. The administrator does not process the provided personal data in a way based on automated processing, including profiling.
