ESSB course - Effective Solutions for Sustainable Buildings

During the course students will learn about actual solutions in the area of sustainable construcions. Students will analyze parameters influencing energy consumption in buildings; consider advantages and disadvantages of different heating, ventilation and airconditioning (HVAC) systems and possibility to apply different energy sources for specific buildings. Students will analyze methods to reduce energy consumption, mantaining a good thermal comfort and a proper indoor air quality.







EVC course - European Vernacular Construction in Context of the Wood and Environmental Sustainability course

During the course students will learn about traditional (from Podlasie, Poland region) and modern solutions inspired by vernacular architecture. Students will analyze climate, geomorfological, urban composition and tradition of vernacular architecture conditions of chosen plot location. Students will consider pros and cons of wooden construction, and propose the idea of design of small building located on this plot. Students will consider arrangement of the plot around the building related to sides of the world and dominant wind directions (climate condition).







STUDY VISITS TO THE COMPANIES ARE PLANNED, WHILE IN THE AFTERNOONS, STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN CULTURAL ACTIVITIES (VISITING BIAŁYSTOK AND ENGAGING IN SPORTS ACTIVITIES).

STUDENTS WILL WORK IN 3-PERSON INTERNATIONAL TEAMS (EACH STUDENT FROM A DIFFERENT UNIVERSITY) TO ENSURE AN INTERNATIONAL AND INTERDISCIPLINARY ENVIRONMENT.
