

Moritzburg and Marktkirche

Marktkirche

evangelic church in the center of Halle(Saale)
built between 1529 and 1554
replaced two former churches in the market area of Halle
considered as one of the most important buildings of the
late Gothic period in central Germany
houses one of the oldest the German church libraries the
so called “Marienbibliothek” (“Marian Library”)



Moritzburg

built in 1503 for archbishops of Magdeburg (capital of Saxony Anhalt)

named after the patron Saint Maurice

was built in the style of the late Gothic/the early Renaissance

in the late 19th century, the Moritzburg got an arts museum with national importance

in 2005 to 2008 the northern and the western part of the Moritzburg got replaced to expand the museum

the Moritzburg is still used as an art museum
