

MEDICAL POLISH COURSE

Introductory requirements: English A2 (pre-intermediate)

- planned duration: 12.09.2022 – 23.12.2022
- 60 lessons – 45 minutes each
- 90 minutes meetings take place twice a week

The course is dedicated to foreigners who want to work in health service in Poland.

The goal of the course is to prepare the participants to:

- communication with patients, patient's family and medical staff
- understanding and completing medical forms (medical clerking)
- job interview

The course includes:

- 1. Polish alphabet.**
- 2. At the doctor's surgery:** questions and answers. Body parts. Diseases and medical problems;
Verb **to have** and **accusative**.
- 3. Personal information – taking history.** questions and answers.
- 4. Body parts, organs and systems. Pain, diseases and disorders taking history.** Body parts and organs – singular and plural. Verb 'hurt' singular and plural form. Verb 'have' - 1st person singular + adjective + noun (body part or organ). Nominative and accusative case – singular and plural.
- 5. Hospitals. Specialists, specialties, and hospital words. Referral to specialists. Specialist medical centers.** Verbs 'want, have to, must'. Finding information in Internet, information plates. Medical abbreviations.
- 6. Medical examination.** Instructions, requests – polite forms.
- 7. At the pharmacy. Forms and types of drugs and dressings.** Giving advice.
- 8. Specialist examinations and laboratory tests.**
- 9. Medical history, minor and major chief complaints. History of present illness.** Questions and answers. Adverbs of frequency. Time expressions. Past forms of verbs "be, have, hurt, suffer from".
- 10. The family history. Past complaints. Style of life.** Time expressions: present and past. Past forms of verbs 'hurt, have, suffer from'. Giving advice. Prohibition.
- 11. Job interview.**
