To be eligible for studying at Bialystok University of Technology, Algerian students applying for a master's program must meet several criteria:

Academic Qualifications :

- **Bachelor's degree ("Licence"):** Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree, equivalent to a "licence" in the Algerian education system.
- Transcript requirements: The grades on the applicant's transcripts must be above 10/20 for all subjects. This ensures that the student meets the minimum academic standards required for admission into a Polish public university.
- **Other eligible degrees:** Candidates with a diploma in architecture, engineering diploma, master's degree, or even a PhD are also eligible to apply.



- Tunisia -

To be eligible for studying in our public university, Bialystok University of Technology, Tunisian students applying for a master's program must meet several criteria:

Academic Qualifications:

Tunisian students must hold a Bachelor's Degree, which can be one of the following:

- Licence Fondamentale
- Licence Professionnelle
- Licence Appliquée

Ineligible Degrees:

The following degrees are not recognized for master's applications:

- 'Brevet de Technicien Supérieur' (BTS)
- "Brevet de Technicien Professionnel" (BTP)
- 'Certificat d'Aptitude Professionelle" (CAP)

Transcript Requirements:

The grades on the applicant's transcripts must be **above** 10/20 for all subjects. This ensures that the student meets the minimum academic standards required for admission into a Polish public university.

Field of Study:

The bachelor's degree ("Licence") should be in the same or a similar field as the master's program being applied for. The relevance of the degree will be reviewed by the admission coordinator during the application process.


Turkish students must hold a bachelor's degree ("Lisans Diplomasi") that lasts a minimum of 4 years.

Transcript Requirements:

The applicant's transcripts must show a minimum grade of 60/100 or CGPA 2.0. This ensures that the student meets the minimum academic standards required for admission into a Polish public university.

Field of Study:

The bachelor's degree ("Lisans Diplomasi") should be in the same or a similar field as the master's program being applied for. The relevance of the degree will be reviewed by the admission coordinator during the application process.

- Zimbabwe-

To be eligible for admission to the master's programs at Bialystok University of Technology, Zimbabwean students must meet the following criteria:

Academic Qualifications:

• Bachelor with Honours: Applicants must hold a Bachelor with Honours degree at a minimum of the Lower Second Division. This degree is typically obtained after completing a 4-5 year program of study and successfully defending a thesis.

Transcript Requirements:

 For the Bachelor with Honours degree, the applicant's transcripts must show a minimum grade equivalent to lower Second Division, which is equivalent to at least 60% out of 100% or 2.2 out of 5.

Ineligible Degrees:

The following degree is not formally recognized in Poland and therefore is not eligible for master's applications:

• Bachelor General: This is a 3-year degree that does not require defense of a thesis.

Field of Study:

The bachelor with Honours should be in the same or a similar field as the master's program being applied for. The relevance of the degree will be reviewed by the admission coordinator during the application process.
